The Stewards, having received a report from the Clerk of the Course (doc.No. 3.9), summoned the representative of the team (STW ind.Communication No.4.1) and having examined the GPS evidence and heard the representative, have considered the matter and determine the following:

Fact: Crew No.26 did not follow Road Book page 191 position No.46 and did not enter Service Park through TC 9C and TC 9D.

Offence: Breach Art.14.2 of the 2019 FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations 2019


Decision: Time penalty of 5 minutes
To Levy a fine of 50 EUR


Reason: Art.14.2 of the 2019 FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations 2019 states that all the crews will receive a road book containing a detailed description of the compulsory itinerary. This itinerary and the road direction positions must be followed. Any deviation will be reported to the Stewards.

The representative of the team Martins Dzenitis explained that the crew understands that they made a serious mistake and they apologise for this, but the mistake was not intentional. The co-driver was driving the car at this point and the driver was reading the notes and he made a mistake and couldn't reverse any more, because there was another car coming from behind.

The fine has to be paid to the Rally HQ manager within 48 hours.


The competitor is reminded of his right to appeal which is stipulated in the 2019 FIA International Sporting Code and in the 2019 FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules.
